
Update

- Established in January 2005 with head quarters in Portland Tower, Manchester
- MaNAP have recruited 6 new Members since recruitment was out sourced to NWIX in April
- 2 new NWIX sites went live in September
- Foundry networks infrastructure upgraded

NWIX Peering LAN (Provided to MaNAP Members)

- MaNAP Ltd is still a trade mutual, not for profit organisation.
- NWIX own and run the MaNAP infrastructure
- Collectively MaNAP Members are a closed user group customer of NWIX (Subject to becoming a MaNAP member)
- Gives Members the ability to peer at any of the NWIX sites
- Takes away the commercial responsibility from the Members
- NWIX delivers more business reasons to join the exchange

- Advanced Fibre network across the North West
- Packet switched Core (Foundry networks)
- Ethernet layer 2 connectivity, supports QinQ
- Certified to BS7799-2 & ISO 9001 information security standards

- Separate and dedicated VLAN's
- NWIX peering LAN
- QinQ Service
- Tail circuits in and around the North West

□ **Layer 3 internet transit via NWIX Peering LAN**

(In association with MaNAP Members)

dependant on becoming a MaNAP Member

- **Private Interconnect**
 - Facilitates private peering via VLAN's or trunked Point 2 Point VLAN
- **QinQ Service**
 - Allows service providers to operate multiple VLAN's between multiple locations on the network
- **Tail Circuits**
 - Allows service providers to connect from the NWIX POP out to their customer site
